

The Excel Foundation Academy was inaugurated on the 14th Nov., 2015, nestled in the shadow of Lhangjol Hills, about a km. West of Churachandpur District Hospital. It is situated just adjacent to South of Chiengkawn Stream, Hqtrs. Veng in the East and Tuinuom Village in the West. The campus of the institution is located at Belam Veng, Headquarters Churachandpur. Admission opens from Preparatory to Class IX.

RULES AND EXPECTATIONS

- 1. All the students are to strictly comply with the rules and regulations of the school.
- 2. Students are expected to be well-groomed and neatly dressed. Girls should not come with fancy clips, earrings and bangles to school, only black rubber band & black clip allowed upon their hair.
- 3. Parents are requested to go through their child's work book and entries made in the school diary everyday.
- 4. Any queries regarding work assignments should be made to the subject teacher concerned by meeting them in person or by calling them at a good time.

- 5. Private tuition is not encouraged but may be recommended only for extra-weak and slow learners. This must be arranged through the principal only.
- 6. Parents are advised to meet their child's teachers at least once a month by making proper appointment after school hours so as to discuss their child's progress or regress if any.
- 7. Promotions are based on the whole years work performance. Regularity in work and attendance are of utmost importance.
- 8. Any child afflicted by infectious disease must complete the quarantine period before rejoining class. If a child is away from school, parents must inform the office or the teacher-in--charge. Students of class I onwards are required to bring a leave letter signed by the parents.
- 9. All the students are to converse only in English. No child is allowed to bring eatables, toys and money to school except for fare
- 10. Complains and queries, if any, should be made to the Principal only and to no other member of the staff.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

- (a) It is compulsory for every child of all class days to be neatly dressed in school uniform. It is an aid to generating a purposeful & disciplined spirit in the attitude of pupils as well as pride in the school. Uniforms will be worn as follows:-
 - * Regular uniform on Monday & Wednesday.
 - * House uniform on Tuesday, Thursday & Friday.
 - * Both kinds of uniforms will be supplied by an authorized dealer.

BOYS - Black short pants and shirt (for Prep. LKG, UKG) black long pants (from Cl-I & above), white shirt with black strip on the forearm.

GIRLS - Black frock (for Prep, LKG & UKG) shirts & white shirt with black strip on the forearm & collar (from Cl-I & above)

SHOES & SOCKS

Black leather/synthetic leather shoes (Naughty boy-type) with black socks, two strips on it.

Black belt only for boys.

HOUSE UNIFORM:

- (a) Grey pants and skirts with school banians according to the respective houses they belong.
- (b) Student's must be in full uniform, whoever likes to meet the Principal during school hours.
- (c) Students who comes to school without full uniform will not be allowed to attend the classroom and may be send home rather in exceptional cases.

3. Tea, snacks and drinking water will be provided only to preparatory class. The rest are to bring their own drinking water.

- 4. School holiday will be observed with prior notification. In case of bandhs and strickes, the school will be closed depending on the situation.
